


Mini Pop-Up Book!

All you need is




To build your Mini Pop-Up Book


Please refer to the numbered diagrams.

- Colour in all the pictures. (If they are already coloured skip this step)
- 2 Cut around the outside of the book template along the line indicated. Remember to cut the line in the middle of the book too.

- 3 Fold the book along the lines.
 Push out the middle where the cut
 is and press book back together.
 Your Pop-Up Book is nearly ready!
- 4 Time for the fun bit! Cut around Mary & Joseph and the bush along the line indicated. Be careful not to cut off the tabs. Fold along the lines marked. Glue the blank side of Tab 1 and 2. Fold the Tabs under and stick underneath the page so they are hidden.
- 5 Cut out the pyramid around the outside. Again, careful not to cut off the tabs. Stick Tab 3 and 4 together to form the pyramid. Fold Tab 5 and 6 underneath. Looking good!
- 6. Now glue the coloured side of Tab 5 and line it up with the shape indicated 'Tab 5 Stick Here' at the base of the pyramid.
- 7. Flatten the pyramid on the right page. It should fit within the edges of the book.

8. Glue Tab 6. Close the book and press down. When you open your booklet the pyramid should pop-up 9. Your Mini Pop-Up Book is ready, enjoy!
