BUTTERFLY PRINTING

Christians like to decorate their churches and homes with symbols of new life to represent the new life we have in Jesus because of his death and resurrection. Consider decorating your home with butterflies as a symbol of new life.

YOU WILL NEED

A4 sheets of paper or card

Paints and big paint brushes

Newspaper or plastic to cover tables

Art smocks or old shirts for those who wish to cover their clothes

WHAT TO DO

- 1. Fold your paper in half, make a crease and then open it again.
- 2. Put some blobs of paint on one side of the crease only.
 Put some towards the middle and some a little further out.
- Fold the paper in half again so it is closed up and rub the outside of the paper smoothly to push the paint around a bit.
- 4. Open up your paper and see your butterfly.
- 5. Put your name on it and leave it somewhere to dry. Then you can use textas to add some features to your butterfly.

*Note: The amount of paint you put on is important. Not enough and the colours won't smudge together, too much and it will come oozing out the sides! The best way is to try one out and then you will know if you need more or less paint.
